VETERINARY REPORT: Loveatfirstsight

Report requested by: Owners of horse / Robert & Jane Clement / Insurance Co.

The above mare underwent resting upper respiratory tract endoscopy at Tamworth Equine Veterinary Centre on the 15th January 2019. The mare had a history of poor performance. On endoscopic examination of the upper respiratory tract there were no significant findings. The mare had grade 1/5 left laryngeal function (normal, synchronous movement). There was no mucous accumulation in the trachea. There were no findings on this examination to suggest a possible cause for the poor performance observed.
