To whom it may concern,

'Solano' was examined on the 7th of May 2019 at Chris Waller Racing's Gold Coast stables for a left forelimb lameness.

The gelding was initially Gr 4/5 lame at the walk with pain on palpation of the distal scapula. There was no evidence of crepitus or pain on manipulation of the shoulder joint. An ultrasound performed on the 8th of May 2019 was suggestive of a fracture line in the caudal aspect of the scapula. The gelding was placed on strict box rest for 6 weeks and phenylbutazone as required.

Following 6 weeks of box rest, 'Solano' was sound at the trot and moved to a small yard. On the 15th of July 2019 'Solano' was sound at the trot with no pain on manipulation of the limb. He was slightly painful on firm palpation of the caudal scapula.

Recommendations:

- If 'Solano' is comfortable at the trot on the 29th July 2019 then he can move to a paddock for a further 6 weeks.

'Solano' has a good prognosis for returning to racing following the paddock rest.
