'Nautibernie' was examined on 2 September 2019 and found to be lame in the right hind leg. Nerve blocks localised the lameness to be originating in the proximal limb or pelvis. In order to gain an accurate diagnosis, nuclear scintigraphy of the hindquarters is recommended.

If nuclear scintigraphy is not performed then it is recommended that the mare be treated conservatively as having a stress fracture and managed with four weeks strict box rest followed by four weeks small yard rest and then four weeks paddock rest before recommencing training.
