The above described horse was examined on the morning of the 24/09/20 at Pineview Lodge Beerwah Qld. A general clinical and lameness examination was performed. At the trot in a straight line on a firm dirt surface there was no lameness evident. There was no response to hoof testers on all four feet. There was no response to flexion tests on all four limbs. The gelding is in good body condition. Auscultation of the heart and lungs revealed no significant findings. There is a mild response to palpation of the proximal suspensory ligament in the RF limb. This palpation does not produce lameness at the trot. There is no filling associated with the RF suspensory ligament. There is dry dermatitis associated with the plantar aspects of both the RH and LH fetlocks. There is no pain on palpation of these regions. The remainder of the clinical exam revealed no other significant findings. The LF fetlock has previously been medicated with Arthramid. The RF and LF fetlocks have been previously medicated with corticosteroid (triamcinolone acetonide).

At the time and within the scope of the current examinations the above described horse is considered suitable to race. This report does not constitute a Prepurchase Examination.
