Horse: Winnipeg

“Winnipeg” has a history of Exercise Induced Pulmonary Haemorrhage (EIPH aka “Bleeder”). Her EIPH has been managed with routine veterinary medication. Following her most recent race endoscopy revealed a Grade 4 EIPH. She has no history of bilateral Epistaxis due to EIPH.

Endoscopy of her larynx reveals normal laryngeal function.


“Winnipeg” is otherwise in good health with normal physical exam findings. She is not currently on any medication. She has no history of any significant orthopaedic conditions. She trots sound in a straight line.

Her prognosis for a future career as a racehorse is poor. If she is to continue in training, she will require ongoing veterinary management of her EIPH.

Her prognosis for retraining in a different career is excellent. Her EIPH will not limit her ability to be retrained in other equestrian discipline.

Her EIPH will have no effect on her ability to be a broodmare.
