On 21st January 2021, on request of J Harron Racing, the 3-year-old bay gelding "Colonel" underwent a clinical examination. At the time of examination, the gelding presented in good general condition and he displayed soundness when walked and trotted in hand on a firm surface. Visual inspection of both eyes was within normal limits, and cardiac auscultation revealed normal rate, rhythm and heart sounds. An assessment of the upper airway was conducted via fiberoptic endoscopic examination. This examination revealed normal pharyngeal anatomy with Grade 2 (Lane Scale) laryngeal function (considered normal).

'Colonel' raced on the day previous to this examination, and at the time of examination it was reported that the gelding had not received any anti-inflammatories.
