# RADIOGRAPHIC & CLINICAL REPORT – GARAVANI Owner: AQUIS

# **HISTORY**

In training in Gold Coast, QLD.

# **CLINICAL EXAM**

Walking and trotting bilateral lame in front and plaits right hind. There is moderate effusion and heat of both fore fetlocks with restriction on flexion. RH fetlock is moderately effused with the hock and stifle NSF. Reactive to palpation across the tuber sacrale.

#### RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Radiographs were taken to assess the bony structures of the front legs and right hind.

#### RF fetlock

- Large saggital ridge OCD distal cannon (pink arrow)
- Moderate supracondylar lysis distal McIII
- Osteophytes off proximal sesamoid bone tip and dorsal proximal medial P1

# LF fetlock

- Moderate saggital ridge OCD distal cannon (pink arrow)
- Moderate supracondylar lysis distal McIII
- Osteophytes off proximal sesamoid bone tip and dorsal proximal medial P1

Right and Left knee – no significant findings

# Right hind fetlock

- Mild supracondylar lysis distal McIII
- Osteophytes off proximal sesamoid bone tip and dorsal proximal P1



# TREATMENT / PLAN

**GARAVANI** has been diagnosed with front and right hind fetlock osteoarthritis. Treatment options for this condition include intra-articular medication, icing, water walking and supportive bandaging during exercise.
