On Tuesday 4th November 2024, Military Mission was examined at Twin Hills Stud, Cootamundra NSW.

The gelding was in paddock condition and found to be generally fit and healthy. He was bright, alert and all vitals signs were within normal limits. The gelding was sound at a trot on a flat, dirt surface.

On physical examination moderate synovial effusion of both front fetlocks was noted with reduced range of motion of the joints. There is an old scar on the medial aspect of the mid-cannon bone (metatarsus III) of the right forelimb. There is firm, boney proliferation underlying the scar. The defect is at the location of the medial splint bone and suspensory ligament. There is a moderate pain response to deep palpation of the area.

The potential clinical significance and appropriate treatment of the noted findings can be better ascertained by radiography of the affected areas.
