Description: 4yo Bay Gelding

I performed a clinical examination on the above-mentioned gelding today at Aristia Park on behalf of the owners. The findings of this examination were within the normal limits of a clinical assessment. The gelding moved freely at the walk and showed no evidence of any lameness. The gelding underwent surgical treatment of synovial sepsis of the left hind digital flexor tendon sheath and septic osteitis of the lateral sesamoid bone (attached surgical report). He has an enlarged fetlock with scarring due to this procedure. There was no reaction to flexion or palpation of the joint and he was sound when observed trotting post flexion test.

No radiography, endoscopy, ultrasonography, electrocardiography or blood testing was requested or performed. This report does not equate to the EVA Five Stage Pre-Purchase Examination certificate.
