Veterinary Report - Rosemont Stud

Date: 08/05/2024 Horse: Capital Call Sex: Gelding Colour: Bay

The horse Capital Call was examined by me on 8 May 2024 at Rosemont Spelling farm. The presenting history was that the gelding was mildly sore bilateral on its front limbs. At today's examination the horse was ambulating well, trotted a grade 1 out of 5 lame on the right hindlimb. The horse was still mildly sore bilaterally on both front feet which is likely to being barefoot. The gelding was reactive to palpation along the R lumbar region extending towards the pelvis and hamstrings. There was no significant joint effusion or swelling noted on the right hind limb.

Based on the above clinical findings, it is highly likely that the gelding has strained or developed a tear along the R lumbar region causing discomfort. The horse has been placed on a short course of antiinflammatories (Phenylbutazone) and will be re-examined. Other options for this gelding may include ultrasound of the R lumbar or regional intramuscular injection along the region with corticosteroids or shockwave therapy.
